

September 07, 2021 COVID 19 Update

Sawyer County continues to be in the “red” risk level of transmission, with a rising seven day average of 30.2 new cases per 100,000 people. This red rate is considered a “high level” of community transmission. The state of Wisconsin is also in the red risk level. Of the new Sawyer County cases, 23.3% are children and another 19.8% are adults over 65. Data has shown that even vaccinated people are contracting and can spread the Delta virus.

Current CDC Masking Guidance recommends that both vaccinated and unvaccinated people wear masks while indoors in public places in communities with substantial and high transmission rates.

**Based on this new information, we are asking that only Town of Spider Lake (TOSL) Town Board members and applicable support persons attend the Town of Spider Lake Town Board meetings as well as all other TOSL Committee meetings until further notice. All other town persons are asked to participate in town meetings via Zoom.**
